AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. COBURN to the amendment (No. 602) proposed by Mr. REID

Viz:

1 At the appropriate place, insert the following:

2 **SEC. ____ . CONSOLIDATING UNNECESSARY DUPLICATIVE**
3 **AND OVERLAPPING GOVERNMENT PRO-**
4 **GRAMS.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, not later
6 than 150 days after the date of enactment of this Act,
7 the Director of the Office of Management and Budget
8 shall coordinate with the heads of the relevant department
9 and agencies to—

10 (1) use available administrative authority to
11 eliminate, consolidate, or streamline Government

1 programs and agencies with duplicative and overlap-
2 ping missions identified in the March 2011 Govern-
3 ment Accountability Office report to Congress, enti-
4 tled “Opportunities to Reduce Potential Duplication
5 in Government Programs, Save Tax Dollars, and
6 Enhance Revenue” (GAO–11–318SP) and apply the
7 savings towards deficit reduction;

8 (2) identify and report to Congress any legisla-
9 tive changes required to further eliminate, consoli-
10 date, or streamline Government programs and agen-
11 cies with duplicative and overlapping missions identi-
12 fied in the March 2011 Government Accountability
13 Office report to Congress, entitled “Opportunities to
14 Reduce Potential Duplication in Government Pro-
15 grams, Save Tax Dollars, and Enhance Revenue”
16 (GAO–11–318SP);

17 (3) determine the total cost savings that shall
18 result to each agency, office, and department from
19 the actions described in paragraph (1); and

20 (4) rescind from the appropriate accounts the
21 amount greater of—

22 (A) \$7,000,000,000; or

23 (B) the total amount of cost savings esti-
24 mated by paragraph (3).
