3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS TO AFRICAN GROWTH AND OP-**
4 **PORTUNITY ACT.**

5 (a) **EXTENSION OF THIRD-COUNTRY FABRIC PRO-**
6 **GRAM.**—Section 112(c)(1) of the African Growth and Op-
7 portunity Act (19 U.S.C. 3721(c)(1)) is amended—

1 (1) in the paragraph heading, by striking
2 “2012” and inserting “2015”;

3 (2) in subparagraph (A), by striking “2012”
4 and inserting “2015”; and

5 (3) in subparagraph (B)(ii), by striking “2012”
6 and inserting “2015”.

7 (b) **ADDITION OF SOUTH SUDAN.**—Section 107 of
8 that Act (19 U.S.C. 3706) is amended by inserting after
9 “Republic of South Africa (South Africa).” the following:

10 “Republic of South Sudan (South Sudan).”.

11 (c) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Section 102(2) of
12 that Act (19 U.S.C. 3701(2)) is amended by striking
13 “48”.

14 (d) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
15 this section shall take effect on the date of the enactment
16 of this Act.

17 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF UNNECESSARY DUPLICATION, RE-**
18 **DUNDANCY, AND OVERLAP OF FEDERAL**
19 **TRADE PROGRAMS.**

20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Di-
21 rector of the Office of Management and Budget shall co-
22 ordinate with the heads of the relevant Federal agencies—

23 (1) to, not later than 60 days after the date of
24 the enactment of this Act, eliminate, consolidate, or
25 streamline Federal programs and Federal agencies

1 with duplicative or overlapping missions relating to
2 trade;

3 (2) to rescind the unobligated balances of all
4 amounts made available for fiscal year 2012 for pro-
5 grams relating to trade for the Department of Com-
6 merce, the Small Business Administration, the Ex-
7 port-Import Bank of the United States, the Overseas
8 Private Investment Corporation, and the Trade and
9 Development Agency, with the amounts rescinded to
10 be deposited in the general fund of the Treasury for
11 purposes of deficit reduction;

12 (3) to reduce spending on programs described
13 in paragraph (2) by not less than \$192,000,000 in
14 fiscal years 2012 and 2013 (including the amounts
15 rescinded pursuant to paragraph (2)); and

16 (4) to report to Congress not later than 180
17 days after the date of the enactment of this Act with
18 recommendations for any legislative changes re-
19 quired to further eliminate, consolidate, or stream-
20 line Federal programs and Federal agencies with du-
21 plicative or overlapping trade missions.
