1 **SEC. 1108. PROHIBITION ON EMERGENCY SPENDING FOR**

3       None of the funds appropriated or made available in  
4 this Act may be used for any commercial fishery that is  
5 located more than .50 miles outside of the boundaries of  
6 a major disaster area, as declared by the President under  
7 the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency As-  
8 sistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5170 et seq.), for Hurricane  
9 Sandy.
