AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. COBURN

Viz:

1       On page 14, line 25, strike “and” at the end and  
2 all that follows through page 15, line 20, and insert the  
3 following:

4           (2) shall implement a modern financial account-  
5       ing and reporting system; and

6           (3) shall, not later than 90 days after the end  
7       of each fiscal year through fiscal year 2012—

8           (A) submit to Congress a comprehensive  
9       report that allocates all of Amtrak’s revenues  
10       and costs to each of its routes, each of its lines

1           of business, and each major activity within each  
2           route and line of business activity, including—  
3                   (i) train operations;  
4                   (ii) equipment maintenance;  
5                   (iii) food service;  
6                   (iv) sleeping cars;  
7                   (v) ticketing; and  
8                   (vi) reservations;  
9           (B) include the report described in sub-  
10          paragraph (A) in Amtrak’s annual report; and  
11          (C) post such report on Amtrak’s website.
