- 1 Beginning on page 173, strike line 1 and all that fol-
- 2 lows through page 174, line 5, and insert the following:
- 3 NORTHERN PLAINS HERITAGE AREA, AMENDMENT
- 4 SEC. 115. (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8004 of the
- 5 Omnibus Public Land Management Act of 2009 (Public
- 6 Law 111–11; 123 Stat. 1240) is amended—
- 7 (1) by redesignating subsections (g) through (i)
- 8 as subsections (h) through (j), respectively;

1 (2) in subsection (h)(1) (as redesignated by
2 paragraph (1)), in the matter preceding subpara-
3 graph (A), by striking “subsection (i)” and inserting
4 “subsection (j)”; and

5 (3) by inserting after subsection (f) the fol-
6 lowing:

7 “(g) REQUIREMENTS FOR INCLUSION AND REMOVAL
8 OF PROPERTY IN A NATIONAL HERITAGE AREA.—

9 “(1) PRIVATE PROPERTY INCLUSION.—No pri-
10 vately owned property shall be included in a Na-
11 tional Heritage Area unless the owner of the private
12 property provides to the management entity a writ-
13 ten request for the inclusion.

14 “(2) PROPERTY REMOVAL.—

15 “(A) PRIVATE PROPERTY.—At the request
16 of an owner of private property included in a
17 National Heritage Area pursuant to paragraph
18 (1), the private property shall be immediately
19 withdrawn from the National Heritage Area if
20 the owner of the property provides to the man-
21 agement entity a written notice requesting re-
22 moval.

23 “(B) PUBLIC PROPERTY.—

24 “(i) INCLUSION.—Only on written no-
25 tice from the appropriate State or local

1 government entity may public property be
2 included in a National Heritage Area.

3 “(ii) WITHDRAWAL.—On written no-
4 tice from the appropriate State or local
5 government entity, public property shall be
6 immediately withdrawn from a National
7 Heritage Area.”.

8 (b) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.—None of the
9 funds made available by this Act shall be made available
10 for a Heritage Area that does not comply with section
11 8004(g) of the Omnibus Public Land Management Act of
12 2009 (Public Law 111–11; 123 Stat. 1240) (as amended
13 by subsection (a)).
