1 At the appropriate place, insert the following:

2 **SECTION ____ . ASSISTANCE TO CHARITIES AND FAMILIES**

3 **IN NEED.**

4 Section 1302 of the Supplemental Appropriations

5 Act, 2009 (Public Law 111–32; 123 Stat. 1909; 49 U.S.C.

6 32901 note) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a)(2)(B), by inserting “or for

8 donation to a charity”; and

9 (2) in subsection (c)(2)—

1 (A) in subparagraph (A), strike “For
2 each” and insert “Except as provided in sub-
3 paragraph (C), for each”;

4 (B) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as
5 subparagraph (D); and

6 (C) by inserting after paragraph (B) the
7 following:

8 “(C) DONATION TO CHARITY.—For each
9 eligible trade-in vehicle surrendered to a dealer
10 under the Program, the dealer may dispose of
11 such vehicle by donating such vehicle to—

12 “(i) an organization that—

13 “(I) is described in section
14 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue
15 Code of 1986 and exempt from tax
16 under section 501(a) of such Code, in-
17 cluding educational institutions,
18 health care providers, and housing as-
19 sistance providers described in such
20 section; and

21 “(II) certifies to the Secretary
22 that the donated vehicle will be used
23 by the organization to further its ex-
24 empt purpose or function, including to
25 provide transportation of individuals

1 for health care services, education,
2 employment, general use, or other
3 purpose relating to the provision of
4 assistance to those in need, including
5 sales to raise financial support for the
6 organization; or

7 “(ii) a family that does not have suffi-
8 cient income to afford, but can dem-
9 onstrate a need for, an automobile.”.
