- 1 Strike section 6025 and insert the following:
- 2 **SEC. 6025. HISTORIC BARN PRESERVATION.**
- 3 Section 379A of the Consolidated Farm and Rural
- 4 Development Act (7 U.S.C. 2008o) is amended—
- 5 (1) in subsection (c)(4)—
- 6 (A) by striking “There are” and inserting
- 7 the following:
- 8 “(A) IN GENERAL.—There are”; and
- 9 (B) by adding at the end the following:

1           “(B) LIMITATION.—If, at any time during  
2           the 2-year period preceding the date on which  
3           funds are made available to carry out this sec-  
4           tion, Congress has provided supplemental agri-  
5           cultural assistance to agricultural producers or  
6           the President has declared an agricultural-re-  
7           lated emergency—

8                   “(i) none of the funds made available  
9                   to carry out this section shall be used for  
10                  the program under this section; and

11                   “(ii) the funds made available to carry  
12                  out this section shall be—

13                           “(I) used to carry out programs  
14                           that address the agricultural emer-  
15                           gencies identified by Congress or the  
16                           President; or

17                           “(II) returned to the Treasury of  
18                           the United States for debt reduction  
19                           to offset the costs of the emergency  
20                           agricultural spending.”; and

21           (2) by adding at the end the following:

22           “(d) REPEAL.—If, during each of 5 consecutive fiscal  
23           years, Congress has provided supplemental agricultural  
24           assistance to agricultural producers or the President has

1 declared an agricultural-related emergency, this section is  
2 repealed.”.
